202 Public Speaking

The subjects of anti-social behaviour and reckless tractor driving were discussed.

Clerk to report: Common Lane potholes, Pilwell Lane deterioration and 7.5 tonne/ Ditch speed limits will be chased up as there is a new contact for this area following an internal reshuffle at DCC.

207 Reports from Village Organisations -

Village Institute – the walls are drying out currently and decorating quotes being sourced with an intention to redecorate in time for this year's village festival. The Institute AGM received a report that the success of last year's event had raised funds for both church and institute as well as a reserve to run again.

1.1 Village Assets / Website updates:

Website information to be updated shortly. It was noted that fibre broadband is still presurvey stage by Digital Derbyshire and that there may be an interest in w3z satellite provision in the village. The clerk is in regular contact with Digital Derbyshire who are also looking into satellite provision for remoter areas.

Play inspection – Cllr Jones is to carry out the interim visual inspections of the play equipment and log these for council. It was agreed to investigate the need for a safer play surface between the equipment and a report will be made to the next meeting. The new noticeboards still have condensation problems and one leaks – clerk to chase the manufacturer. It is noted that the Church are looking for assistance to replace their noticeboards – Council will consider this at the next meeting.
