2 parishioners discussed the problems of the Illy Willy flooding the drainage system and flowing out to currently create a flooded road section near Town End on Main Street. One of them is a retired Highways Engineer and Council is pleased to accept his offer to conduct a professional survey and submit his findings to Council to pass to DCC Highways to look at a long term solution. It was noted that the soakaway was put in 45 years ago and that the gullies appear to collapsed in several sections with the water force now even lifting road tarmac creating potholes.

The applicant for 1102 presented his case for an affordable needs dwelling for his daughter which is designed to resemble a small stone barn.
